92 VDOT Hot Lane Update

Carl Iddings provided an update on the sound barrier study performed by VDOT. He stated that VDOT performed the sound study using two standards for noise abatement and since the Association was not pleased with the results of the sound study, the Association contracted Wyle Laboratories to conduct an independent sound study, which unfortunately, was in agreement with the sound study performed by VDOT. He stated that the Association has two options: (1) request that VDOT review its barrier design by addressing the noise levels at 4020 Lafayette Village Drive or (2) the Association can ask local elected officials to ask VDOT to conform to Fairfax County noise abatement standards.

Reserve Study/2009 Budget

Sean Walsh discussed the Reserve Study. He stated that the Reserve Study is being prepared by Miller-Dodson Associates, and consists of Miller-Dodson coming in and looking at items and then advising the Association as to what items need to be replaced. In addition, Mr. Walsh reviewed the 2009 budget and reported that ideally the reserves should be at \$75,000.00 each year; however, currently the amount in the reserves is approximately \$44,000.00. Mr. Walsh said that in order to increase the reserves the Association will have to increase assessments by 10% for the upcoming year.
