**WORK SCHEDULE FOR THE
ASPHALT REJUVENATION PROJECT**

Section A: Trammel Court, Mt. Airey, Butterfield Lane, Hancock Forest Trail, Pool Parking Lot.

Monday April 29th by 7:30 am: Tow vehicles which have not been moved. **Residents are required to pay towing fee.**

Clean and apply the asphalt rejuvenator to the streets.
Leave streets closed down over night.

Tuesday, April 30th:

Crack seal the streets & repaint.
Open the streets to traffic once paint dries.

Section B: Yorktown Village Pass, Newport Glen Pass, Brunswick Forest Pass, Hampton Village Pass.

Wednesday, May 1st by 7:30 am: Tow vehicles which have not been moved. **Residents are required to pay towing fee.**

Clean and apply the asphalt rejuvenator to the streets.
Leave streets closed down over night.

Thursday, May 2nd:

Crack seal the streets & repaint.
Open the streets to traffic once paint dries.

Section C: Colonial Village Way, Byrds Nest Pass, Peyton Forest Trail, Ashley Glen Road.

Friday, May 3rd by 7:30 am: Tow vehicles which have not been moved. **Residents are required to pay towing fee.**

Clean and apply the asphalt rejuvenator to the streets.
Leave streets closed down over night.

Saturday, May 4th:

Crack seal the streets & repaint.
Open the streets to traffic once paint dries

WARNING: The materials used for the Asphalt Rejuvenation will ruin anything it comes in contact with until it dries. This includes shoes, tires, toys & etc. Also, the material is not good for pets to come in contact with. **So please remain OFF the community streets until the contractor has opened them to traffic again.** Neither the contractor nor Lafayette Village Community Association is responsible for any damages due to individuals not following these instructions.

The Asphalt Rejuvenation cannot be done in rainy weather. If we experience rain one day, the work scheduled for that day will be moved to the next day. I will be issuing LVCA Announcements every evening detailing the progress of the project and the work expected to be performed the next day.
